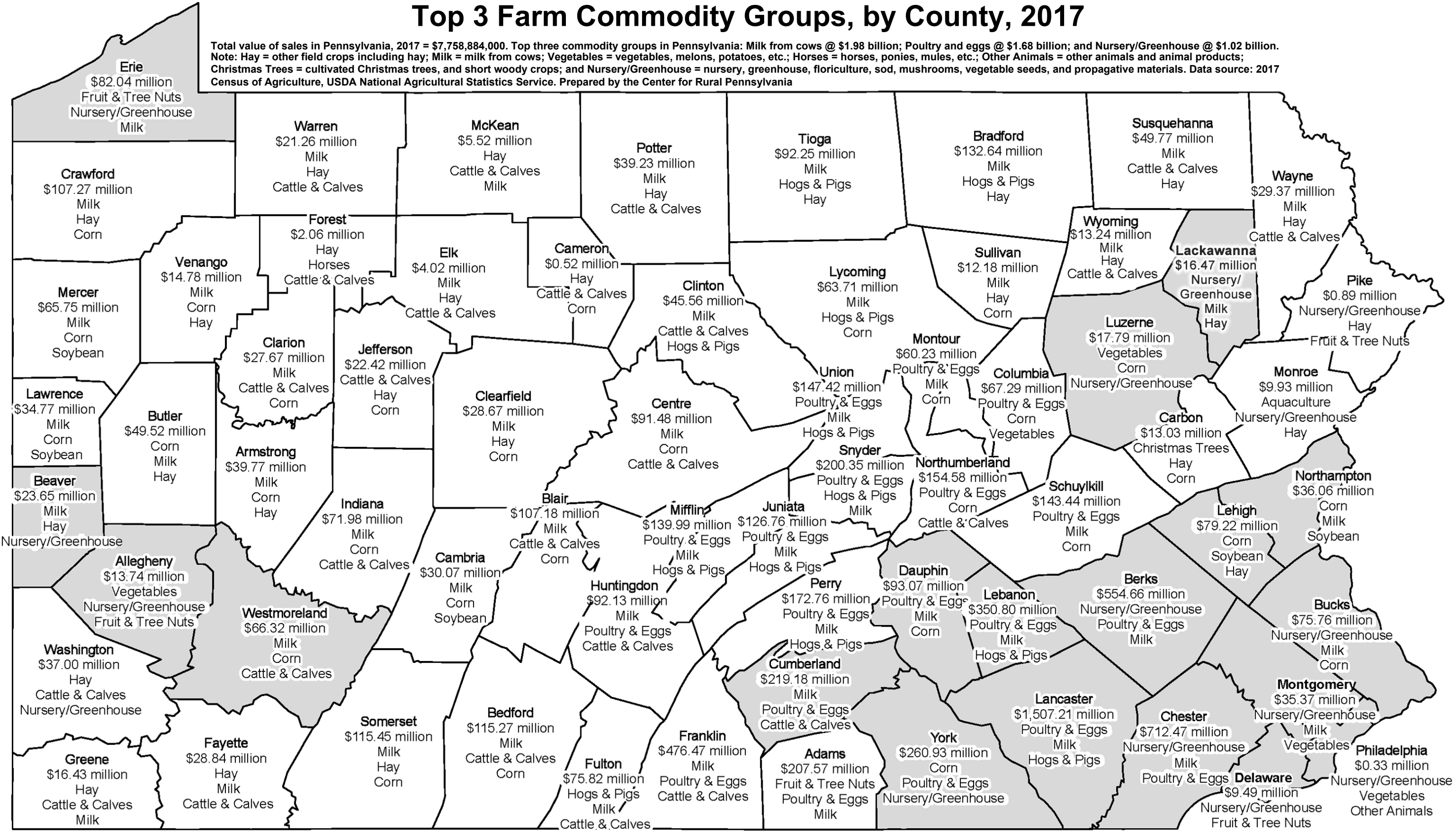


Top 3 Farm Commodity Groups, by County, 2017

Total value of sales in Pennsylvania, 2017 = \$7,758,884,000. Top three commodity groups in Pennsylvania: Milk from cows @ \$1.98 billion; Poultry and eggs @ \$1.68 billion; and Nursery/Greenhouse @ \$1.02 billion.
 Note: Hay = other field crops including hay; Milk = milk from cows; Vegetables = vegetables, melons, potatoes, etc.; Horses = horses, ponies, mules, etc.; Other Animals = other animals and animal products; Christmas Trees = cultivated Christmas trees, and short woody crops; and Nursery/Greenhouse = nursery, greenhouse, floriculture, sod, mushrooms, vegetable seeds, and propagative materials.
